### PRIMARY SETUP

---

- **Players:** 2x Pioneer CDJ-3000, CDJ-3000X, or CDJ-2000NXS2 (Linked, latest stable firmware).
- **Mixer:** 1x Pioneer DJM-A9, V10, 900NXS2, 900nexus, 850, 800, or S9.
- **Mic:** 1x Wireless mic.

### ALTERNATIVE SETUP

---

*Pioneer All-in-One systems are accepted if primary gear is strictly unavailable.*

- **Accepted:** Pioneer XDJ-AZ, XDJ-XZ, XDJ-RX3, XDJ-RX2, XDJ-RR, OPUS-QUAD, OMNIS-DUO.
- **Mic:** 1x Wireless mic.

**NOT ACCEPTED:** XDJ-RX1, XDJ-AERO, or any non-Pioneer/AlphaTheta brands.

### BOOTH & LAYOUT

---

- **Monitors:** 1x High-Power Booth Monitor setup (no brand preference, but must be adequate for the room).
- **Space:** Minimum 1 meter of depth space strictly within the DJ booth.
- **Table:** Stable surface, 90cm to 1m high. Must be ample enough to comfortably lay headphones and microphones on.

### HOSPITALITY

---

- **Water:** Still water required in the booth for all sets.
- **Beverages:** Soft drinks (Pepsi Max, Coke Zero, etc.) are well accepted.

- **Food:** Sandwich/finger food required for sets lasting 6+ hours (exception: club night-time sets).
- **Guestlist:** Guestlist access for up to 10 people, including team and friends, with food/drinks as described above.

## ENVIRONMENT & STANDARDS

---

- **Maintenance:** The gear provided must be perfectly working, without any physical or software flaws (no missing parts, no unstable software).
- **Cable Management:** Cables must be hidden from the dancefloor's POV. No loose cables near the mixer/CDJs or on the booth's floor.
- **Cleanliness:** All gear must be clean within professional standards, completely free from cigarette ashes, drink stains, and sticky residue.

## BRANDING & PROMOTION

---

- **Promotion:** The promoter and venue will tag the DJ on all related posts on social media channels.
- **Naming:** Related flyers, lineups, and communication will spell the name of the DJ correctly strictly as follows: "**FLOYER\***", "**FLOYER**", or "**Floyer**", and use the official provided logos.
- **Visuals:** Any visual content—both online, offline, and live (including VJ and LED walls)—must include the official assets provided and follow the linked design guidelines.
